Jesus: the One and Only! Resurrection Sunday – April 4, 2021

introduction: “one-in-a-million”

Jesus is the one and only person . . .

1. to be both God and man (Philippians 2:5-7; Isaiah 9:6; Matthew 8:23-27)
2. qualified to die and take the punishment for our sins (Philippians 2:8; 1 Corinthians 15:3; Romans 3:23; Romans 6:23; Hebrews 4:15; John 19:30; Romans 5:8)
3. to predict His own resurrection, then die and rise from the dead just as He predicted (1 Corinthians 15:4; Matthew 20:17-19)
4. who will reign forever (Philippians 2:9-11; Revelation 11:15)

personal application: Put your faith in Jesus alone for salvation (John 14:6; Matthew 1:21; Acts 16:31; Ephesians 2:8-9).

Personal application: Tell others about Jesus: who He is, what He has done for them on the cross, and how their eternal destiny and earthly life will be changed if they will trust Him and serve Him as their Savior and Lord (Acts 4:12; 1 Timothy 2:5; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Romans 10:13-14).
