Hebrews 11: The Bible's "Hall of Faith" Chapter

Trusting and Serving God, and Forsaking the Temporary Pleasures of Sin Hebrews 11:24-26 October 23, 2022

introduction: review of Exodus chapters 1-2
1. Reject any pleasures that sin seems to offer. Such pleasures are only temporary — not nearly as important as faithfully trusting and serving God (Hebrews 11:24-25).
supporting Scriptures: Acts 7:25 Psalm 16:11
personal application:Minimize the pleasures of sin, and maximize the long-lasting consequences of sin.
2. Anysuffering for the Lord's sake is only temporary (Hebrews 11:25-26).
Moses wrote about Jesus in the first five books of the Old Testament! (John 5:46; Deuteronomy 18:15; John 1:45; Acts 26:22-23)
personal application: Keep trusting and servingGod; that brings eternal rewards that are far greater than the suffering of this life.
