The First Song in the Bible's Songbook Psalm 1 January 29, 2023

introduction: Psalm 1 is a fitting introduction to the entire book of Psalms. It summarizes the two basic ways by which people choose to live: the way of the righteous person and the way of the wicked person (Matthew 7:13-14).

1. Psalm 1:1-3 — Theblessed person (godly person):
1) avoidswicked influences, deeds, and attitudes (Psalm 1:1) supporting Scripture: Proverbs 27:17
2) delights inthe word of God (Psalm 1:2)
3) thrives and prospers spiritually as a result of being rooted in God's word (Psalm 1:3) supporting Scripture: Joshua 1:8
2. Psalm 1:4-5 — Theungodly person:
1) is likechaff — the worthless outer shell that is removed from grain in the threshing process (Psalm 1:4)
2) will not be able to withstand God'sjudgment (Psalm 1:5) supporting Scriptures: Revelation 6:17; Revelation 20:11, 15 Romans 8:1
3. Psalm 1:6 — The knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the ungodly shall perish.
