introduction: Luke 24:44-45

Specific statements in Psalms pointing forward to Jesus' crucifixion — some put in writing up to 1000 years in advance! — include:

5. He would be given \_\_\_\_ vinegar \_\_\_\_\_ to drink (Psalm 69:21).

applied to Jesus in Matthew 27:33-34

6. Lots would be cast for His \_\_\_\_\_ clothing \_\_\_\_\_ (Psalm 22:18). supporting Scripture: Proverbs 16:33

applied to Jesus in Matthew 27:35-36

7. He would be \_\_\_\_\_ ridiculed \_\_\_\_\_ (Psalm 22:7-8). supporting Scriptures: John 2:19, 21

applied to Jesus in Matthew 27:39-43

8. God the Father would \_\_\_\_ forsake \_\_\_\_\_ Him (Psalm 22:1). supporting Scriptures: 1 Peter 3:18; 2 Corinthians 5:21; John 3:16

applied to Jesus in Matthew 27:46

9. He would commit His \_\_\_\_\_ spirit \_\_\_\_\_ to God the Father (Psalm 31:5). supporting Scriptures: John 10:17-18

applied to Jesus in Luke 23:46

10. None of His \_\_\_\_\_ bones \_\_\_\_\_ would be broken (Psalm 34:20).

applied to Jesus in John 19:31-36
