Lots would be cast for His clothing (Psalm 22:18). supporting Scripture: Proverbs 16:33 applied to Jesus in Matthew 27:35-36 7. He would be ridiculed (Psalm 22:7-8). supporting Scriptures: John 2:19, 21 applied to Jesus in Matthew 27:39-43 8. God the Father would forsake Him (Psalm 22:1). supporting Scriptures: 1 Peter 3:18; 2 Corinthians 5:21; John 3:16 applied to Jesus in Matthew 27:46 9. He would commit His spirit to God the Father (Psalm 31:5). supporting Scriptures: John 10:17-18 applied to Jesus in Luke 23:46 10. None of His bones would be broken (Psalm 34:20). applied to Jesus in John 19:31-36
