What's So Special About the Cross? April 2, 2023

introduction: There are crosses on display in lots of places. Why? Because of the cross upon which Jesus died.
1. God'seternal plan included the crucifixion of Jesus (1 Peter 1:18-20).
2. The Old Testament prophecies about the Messiah included predictions of His suffering and death (1 Peter 1:10-11; Isaiah 53:3-7; Psalm 22:16; Matthew 26:58; 2 Peter 1:21).
3. The reason Jesus came toearth was so He could die on the cross for our sins (Philippians 2:5-8; Luke 19:10; Matthew 16:21; Matthew 26:2).
4. Jesus' death on the crossglorified God (John 12:27-28).
supplemental Scripture: 1 Peter 4:16
5. Jesus' death on the cross is the essence of thegospel (1 Corinthians 15:3; Romans 5:6-8; 1 Peter 3:18).
6. Jesus died on the cross foreveryone (Hebrews 2:9; 1 Timothy 2:5-6).
7. Jesus' death on the cross is a central theme of those who are in the Lord's presence (Revelation 5:11-12).
personal applications:
1. If you have never done so, put your faith in Jesus alone for salvation (Hebrews 2:3; John 1:12; Acts 4:12).
2Tell others that Jesus is the only Savior and urge them to put their faith in Him alone and be saved (Romans 10:14-15; Romans 6:23).
