**Is Your Soul Thirsty for God?**

**Psalm 63**

**June 28 2023**

introduction: The ground can be thirsty for water. God used David to write this psalm when he was in the wilderness of Judah, and David expresses the thirst of his soul for God.

1. Does God mean more to you than life? You can and should still praise Him when life involves undesirable circumstances (Psalm 63:1-4).
