sermon notes

From Tormenting Guilt to Complete Forgiveness Psalm 32:1-5 June 4, 2023

introduction: David's sins of adultery and murder (2 Samuel chapter 11)

1. Exuberant happiness is experienced by those whose sins have been forgiven by God, those whose sins God does not put to their account (Psalm 32:1-2, 5).

supporting Scriptures: Psalm 1:1 Psalm 103:12 Exodus 34:7 2 Corinthians 5:21 1 Peter 2:24

personal application: Tell others that all their sins can be forgiven and no longer held against them by God if they will put their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Savior.

supporting Scriptures: Romans 4:4-8 1 John 1:7 Ephesians 1:7

2. There are physical and emotional consequences of refusing to admit your sins to God in daily life (Psalm 32:3-4).

personal application: In daily life, confess your sins to God. Agree with Him about your sins.
