Praise the Lord for Who He Is and What He Does Psalm 145:8-9 — August 13, 2023

introduction: The Christian life involves responding appropriately to who God is and what He does. For example, “We love Him because He first loved us” (1 John 4:19). Psalm 145 declares various attributes of God, and we should respond appropriately by praising Him. To praise means to express admiration.

4. Praise the Lord for His _____ mercy _____ (Psalm 145:8). He does not treat us as severely as our sins deserve.
