The Most Unique Person Ever Born: Fully God and Fully Man
John 1:1, 14; Philippians 2:5-8
December 24, 2023

introduction: The heaviest baby, the tiniest baby, the most premature baby. Luke 2:7 records the birth of the most unique baby ever.

1. Jesus always has been, and always will be, fully God (John 1:1, 3; Philippians 2:5-6).

supporting Scriptures: John 8:58
Luke 2:11
John 20:28
Titus 2:13

personal application: Worship Jesus. He is worthy! (Philippians 2:9-11).

2. Jesus took on a human body and came to earth — fully man (John 1:14; Philippians 2:7-8). The theological term is “incarnate,” meaning “in flesh.”

supporting Scriptures: Isaiah 7:14
Isaiah 9:6
Colossians 2:9

Lewis Sperry Chafer stated, “Jesus became God’s ideal man, and Jesus is man’s ideal God.”

3. Because Jesus is fully God and fully man, He is uniquely qualified:

1) to reveal to us what God is like (John 14:9; Romans 5:8; John 1:17).

2) to provide a ransom and a sacrifice for sins, in order to save sinful people and reconcile them to God (1 Timothy 2:5-6; Ephesians 5:32; 1 Peter 3:18; Luke 19:10; 1 Timothy 1:15).
Tell others they can be saved through faith in Jesus.

3) to help us in every difficult situation we go through (Hebrews 4:15-16; Luke 1:37).
