**A Very Unlikely, but Very Effective, Witness for the Lord  
John chapter 4  
December 3, 2023**

introduction: “Mary Was the First One to Carry the Gospel.”

“Go Tell It on the Mountain.”

“Go spread the news of Emmanuel . . . Tell the world His name is Jesus.”

Romans 10:13-14

1. The Lord loves and wants to save people of \_\_\_\_\_ all \_\_\_\_\_ different nationalities and races and backgrounds (John 4:1-9, 15-26).

2. Use ways to present the truth of \_\_\_\_\_ salvation \_\_\_\_\_ that are relevant to people’s individual lives (John 4:10-14). Jesus told the woman who had come to a well to get water that He provides “living water” — a figure of speech for the way He is able to quench a person’s deep spiritual thirst and give them everlasting life.

supporting Scriptures: John 3 (“You must be born again.”)

Luke 19:10

3. Tell people what you know about \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ and what effect He has had in your life. God can use your witness to bring others to salvation (John 4:28-30, 39-42).
