| devoutly = devoted to the Lord, set apart to serve Him, holy justly = righteously, measuring up to what God expects and requires blamelessly = unreproachable, able to stand up to scrutiny |
| 4. Encourage others to walkworthy of God (1 Thessalonians 2:11-12) |
