Not the Word of Men, but the Word of God 1 Thessalonians 2:13 — March 3, 2024

introduction: The apostle Paul spoke in the synagogue in the city of Thessalonica for three Sabbaths. Paul spoke, but it was not the word of a man; it was the word of God.

3) The Bible's ______ is evidence it is the word of God.

1. The Bible was written over a period of approximately 1550 years (from about 1445 B.C. to about 95 A.D.).

2. The sixty-six individual books of the Bible were written by approximately 40 human writers from various backgrounds.

3. The individual books of the Bible were written in different places — portions of it were written on three continents: Africa, Europe, and Asia

4. The Bible's subject matter includes many controversial subjects – God, angels, Satan, people, life and death, sin and salvation, heaven and hell.

Yet the Bible's human writers wrote on controversial subjects with unity and harmony. That's not the result of chance. God superintended human writers who were different from each other to give us a unified Bible.

4) The Bible's historical and prophetic accuracy is evidence it is the word of God.
