### The Day of the Lord 1 Thessalonians 5:1-3 - sermon for June 30, 2024

introduction: There is a difference between what is called “the Lord’s Day” (Revelation 1:10) and what is called “the Day of the Lord” (1 Thessalonians 5:1) in the Bible.

introductory Scriptures: Acts 1:6-7; Matthew 24:36; Mark 13:33

1. Throughout the \_\_\_\_\_ Bible \_\_\_\_\_, the term “the Day of the Lord” is used in reference to times when God intervenes directly and dramatically in world affairs and sends judgment upon people and nations that have rebelled against Him.
