Jesus' Grand Entrance into Jerusalem John 12:12-15 April 13, 2025

introduction: In Bible times, as many Jews as possible would travel from wherever they lived to Jerusalem to celebrate Passover. John chapter 12 records Jesus traveling to Jerusalem for the Passover celebration.

1. Jesus is ______ to be praised (John 12:12-13).

supporting Scriptures: Psalm 118:22-26

The word "save" (Psalm 118:25) is the translation of the Hebrew word *hosanna*, which was a cry to the Lord for help in Old Testament times. As time passed, *hosanna* also became an expression of praise.

supporting Scriptures: John 6:!5 Zechariah 14:9 Matthew 27:15-26

personal application: _____Praise_____ the Lord Jesus Christ for who He is and what He has done.

supporting Scriptures: Psalm 145:3 Psalm 40:1-3 Psalm 150:6

personal application: _____Believe____ the prophecies God has revealed in the Bible, including its prophecies about heaven for those who are saved and everlasting punishment for those who are not saved.

According to Professor Peter W. Stoner, Chairman of the Departments of Mathematics and Astronomy at Pasadena City College, the mathematical probability of one person in the first century fulfilling just eight of the most clear and straightforward Messianic prophecies is 1 in 100,000,000,000,000 — 1 in 100 quadrillion! And Jesus fulfilled dozens of Old Testament prophecies!
