sermon notes

The Oldest Mother Who Ever Give Birth **Genesis chapters 11-21** May 11, 2025 — Mother's Day

introduction: Examples of women in their 60s and 70s who gave birth to a child — but all by artificial insemination or the result of fertility treatments, not natural conception.
1. Trust God to keep His promises and take care of you in His way and in His timing (Genesis 11:29-30; Genesis 12:1-7; Genesis 15:1-6).
In Genesis 12:1-3, God gave Abram three important promises:
1) a blessing (Genesis 12:2a)
2) a blessing (Genesis 12:2b-13a)
3) aworldwide blessing (Genesis 12:3b)
supporting Scripture: Galatians 3:8; Hebrews 2:9; 1 Timothy 2:5-6; Isaiah 26:3
Perhaps the clearest example of how people weresaved in Old Testament times is Genesis 15:6 — saved through faith in the Lord.
supporting Scriptures: Romans 4:2-3; Romans 10:9-10, 13
2. There can be long-lasting consequences of a single foolish decision or sinful action (Genesis 16:1-4, 15-16).
supporting Scripture: 1 John 1:9
God promises to forgive our sins when we confess them, but He does not promise to remove the

consequences.

3. Keep trusting God when your situation seems ___impossible_ (Genesis 17:17-21; Genesis 18:10-15; Genesis 21:1-7).

supporting Scripture: Hebrews 11:11; Matthew 19:26
