Something Involving Creation That Was Not Good
Genesis 2:18-20 — June 7, 2026

introduction: God repeatedly stated that things He created were good (Genesis 1:4, 10, 12, 18, 21, 25). But there came a point when God said something was not good.

main truth: God is aware of our _____ needs _____, and He has wonderful ways of meeting our needs.

The events in Genesis 2:7-25 occurred on the ___sixth___ day of creation. God's statement in Genesis 2:18 was made before He completed His creative work that day. When He had finished His creative work, He made the statement recorded in Genesis 1:31 — that everything He made was very good.
